By Bus

All bus routes to/from Amersham call at Amersham Underground and National Rail Stations.

Timetables for all routes serving Amersham are available on Buckinghamshire Council's website at: www.buckscc.gov.uk/services/transport-and-roads/buses-and-trains/bus-timetables

1/1A/1B High Wycombe – Chesham – Hemel Hempstead Daily

High Wycombe – Hazlemere – Holmer Green – Amersham Hospital – Old Amersham, Broadway – **Amersham, Woodside Road*** – Amersham Station – Chesham Bois – Chesham – Hemel Hempstead

Chesham – Monday to Saturday daytime every 15 minutes, evenings 30-60 minutes. Sunday daytime every 60 minutes.
Hemel Hempstead (Service 1) – daily every 60 minutes

*1A/1B journeys operate via Station Road – alight at Chesham Road or Amersham Station. Operated by Carousel Buses

71/73 Whelpley Hill – Amersham – Little Chalfont/Coleshill Mon-Sat

Whelpley Hill – Ley Hill – Chesham – Chesham Bois – **Grimsdell's Lane/Plantation Road** – Amersham Station – Little Chalfont – or Amersham Hospital – Penn Street/Coleshill

Monday to Friday – hourly service between Chesham and Amersham. 4/5 journeys to/from Whelpley Hill and Little Chalfont or Coleshill.

Saturday – 4/5 journeys to Coleshill only. Operated by Red Rose Travel

106/107 Slough – Gerrards Cross – The Chalfonts – Amersham Mon-Sat

Slough – Wexham – Wexham Park Hospital – Stoke Poges, Sefton Park (106) – Fulmer (107) – Gerrards Cross – Chalfont St Peter – Chalfont Common – Chalfont St Giles – Little Chalfont – **Amersham, Woodside Road** – Amersham – Chesham*

Monday to Saturday daytime approximately every 60 minutes
*1 early morning Monday to Friday return journey serves Chesham – alight at Chesham Road or Amersham Station. Operated by Carousel Buses

By Bike

Pindar Creative is located near The Chiltern Heritage Cycling Trails and The Chilterns Cycleway.

The Chiltern Heritage Cycling Trails – Each of the three circular routes connects scenic towns and parishes of the Chilterns Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty. 'Milton' and 'Harding' routes pass through Amersham and the 'Hampden' route can be joined at Chesham Bois via Harding route. The Chilterns Cycleway – 170 mile circular cycle route through the Chilterns AONB, taking in the best of the Chilterns scenery. The route is mainly on-road and is signposted throughout. Information can be found on Chilterns AONB website. <https://www.chilternsaonb.org/cycleway.html>

By Rail

Metropolitan Line – Amersham to Aldgate via Baker Street. Two trains per hour to/from Amersham. All trains serve Harrow-on-the-Hill, however some trains do not serve all stations between Moor Park and Finchley Road. Approximate journey time from Baker Street is 50 minutes.

Amersham – Chalfont & Latimer – Chorleywood – Rickmansworth – Moor Park – Northwood – Northwood Hills – Pinner – North Harrow – Harrow-on-the-Hill – Northwick Park – Preston Road – Wembley Park – Finchley Road – Baker Street – Great Portland Street – Euston Square – King's Cross St. Pancras – Farringdon – Barbican – Moorgate – Liverpool Street – Aldgate

Chiltern Railways operates between London Marylebone and Aylesbury – every 30 minutes Monday-Saturday, hourly late evenings and Sunday. London Marylebone – Harrow-on-the-Hill – Rickmansworth – Chorleywood – Chalfont & Latimer – Amersham – Great Missenden – Wendover – Stoke Mandeville – Aylesbury – Aylesbury Vale Parkway

Folding bicycles are permitted on Chiltern services at all times provided they are fully folded and stored without hindering other passengers. Regular bicycles can be carried on any Chiltern Railways trains – Mondays to Fridays: most trains except busiest peak hour services. Public Holidays/Weekends: subject to space being available, and at the discretion of staff.

By Car

Finding your way to Pindar Creative by car is relatively simple. If you have a SatNav enter the postcode **HP6 6HJ** or What3Words: **///violin.grace.twins**.

Alternatively, if you are following a map please see below for suggested route options, then as you approach Amersham refer to the map overleaf.

From M25 north – exit M25 at jct 18 (A404) and then follow signs for Amersham.

From M25 south – exit M25 at jct 16 for M40 (west), follow for 4 miles. Exit M40 at jct 2, follow signs for Beaconsfield (A355), then Amersham.

From M40 west – leave the M40 at jct 2, then follow signs for Beaconsfield (A355) to Amersham.

From A413 Aylesbury – follow signs for Amersham.

From M1 north – exit M1 at jct 8, take the A414 to Hemel Hempstead, then follow signs for the A41 towards Aylesbury for approximately 3 miles. Take the A416 to Chesham, then onto Amersham.

From M5/M4 – exit M4 near Slough, follow the A355 towards Beaconsfield and then Amersham.

Pindar Creative actively promotes sustainable modes of travel. If the only viable option is travelling by car we encourage car sharing to make journeys more environmentally friendly. Parking spaces will be available for customer visits.

On Foot

Amersham Underground and National Rail Station – 0.7 miles (1.2 km), 14 minutes.

Nearest bus stops to Pindar offices:

- **Grimsdell's Lane/Plantation Road** – 0.2 miles (0.35 km), 4 minutes for bus service 71/73.
- **Green Lane/Woodside Road** – 0.4 miles (0.7 km), 8 minutes for bus services 1, 103, 105.
- **Rickmansworth Road/Chesham Road** – 0.6 miles (1 km), 13 minutes for bus services 1/1A, 105.
